Item #6 - FBO Report – Johnson reported that new stickers/logos have been added to the fuel trucks. These are now required. The fuel trucks did not get calibrated when the fuel pumps were calibrated. Johnson will call the company and schedule them to come and complete the calibration of the trucks. They have had some people interested in hangar availability and also interest in buying airplanes. Johnson has heard comments from many outside users of the airport and he believes we could look at increasing the infrastructure and facility fees. De-icing equipment has been of discussion also. Krogstad wondered if the applying of the chemical would have to be done by someone that is certified. Johnson isn't sure but will find out. Wilde believes that Titan may be able to provide training.
