Summary and Recommended Action:

Staff recommends approval of the proposed Resolution rejecting all bids for the Edgebrook Golf Course Water Sourcing Project. This will allow time for redesign and rebidding based on the updated scope to be in alignment with the proposed project budget.

Item Details:

On November 6, 2025, bids were opened for the Edgebrook Golf Course Water Sourcing Project. The low bid came in \$736,000 above the engineer's estimate, largely due to significantly higher mobilization and dewatering costs. Since the bid opening, discussions have been held about a potential design modification that could substantially reduce project costs while still meeting the project's objectives.
