

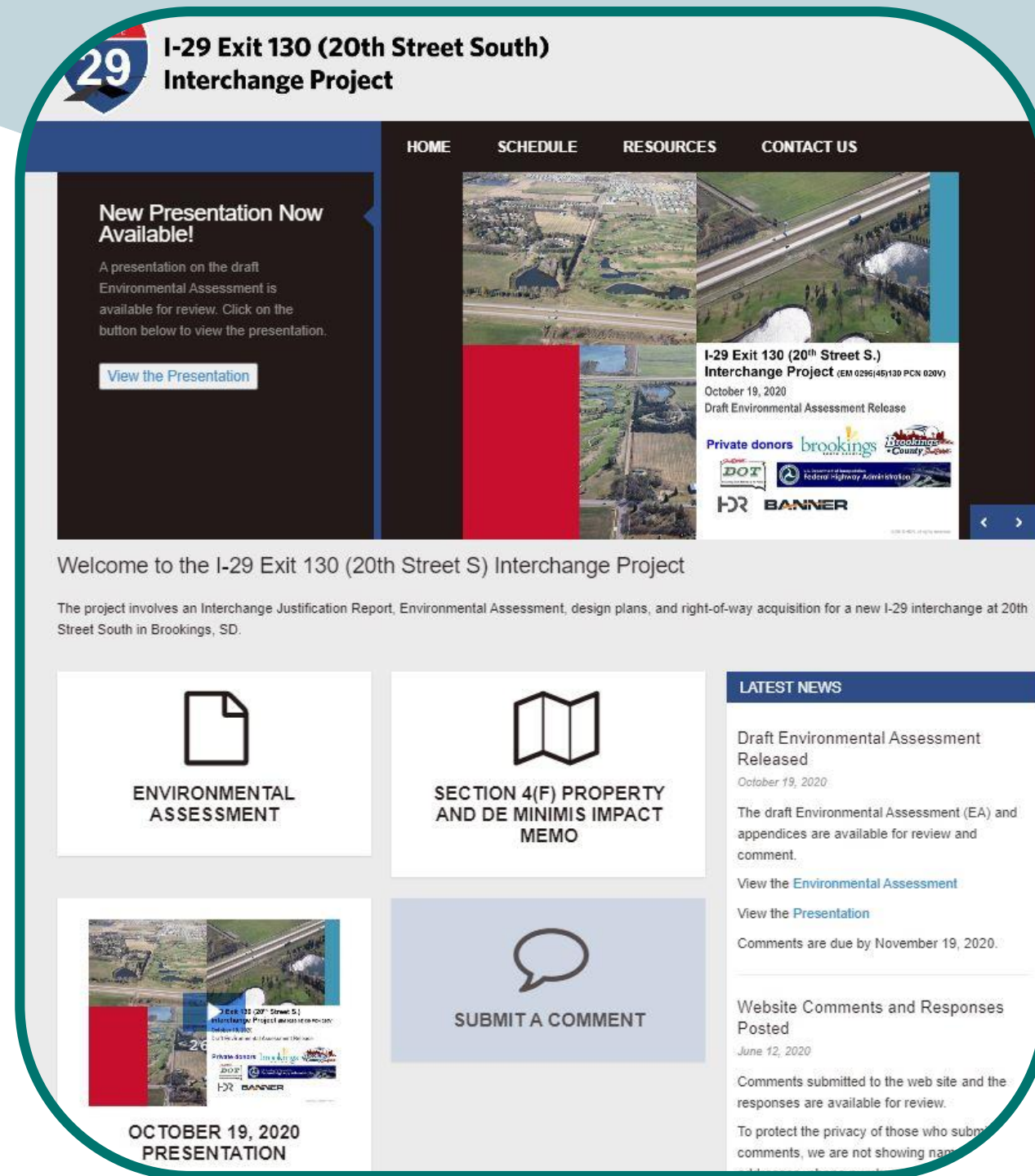

- Completion – August 2021



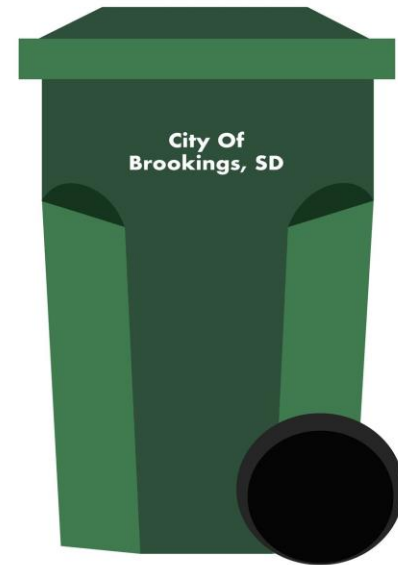
