Summary and Recommended Action:

Staff recommends approval of the proposed resolution declaring surplus property.

Item Details:

According to State Statute Chapter 6-13, the governing body of the City of Brookings allows City property, as presented within the proposed Resolution, to be declared as surplus property and includes

Police Department: Glock G17 9mm Pistol, duty gun to be presented to Terry Coon in honor of his retirement. A 2018 Ford Interceptor.

Library: Alphabet rug, bulletin boards, table and chairs, slat wall pieces, refrigerators, plastic folding table, exercise ball chair base, and flip-top tables.

Street Division: Bobcat skid steers, Bobcat snow tires, Bobcat angle broom, John Deere hydraulic plow mounts for motor graders, Falcon asphalt heater/recycler, Crafcoc Mastic Patcher, Crafcoc crack sealer, Graco walk behind line stripers, Hyster fork lift, Polaris UTV tracks, Clarke Grizzly ULV fogger, Chevrolet pickups, Husqvarna push mower, Mikasa Plate Compactor, Maruyama backpack sprayer, EZ Liner line striper, and Street Heat Thermoplastic Melter.
