Subject: Resolution 23-087: Awarding Bids for Portable Litter Control

Fences

Summary:

Staff recommends resolution approval for ten (10) portable litter control fences with Metta Technologies, Inc. for \$81,260. This is within the 2023 budgeted amount.

Background:

The City utilizes permanent fencing around the landfill to help control litter from leaving the grounds. These portable litter control fences will be used in the active working face for additional measure to help control litter and the ability to adjust based on the current weather conditions.

Item Details:

The City opened bids for (10) Portable Litter Control Fences on Tuesday, August 22, 2023 at 1:30 pm at the City & County Government Center. Two bids were received:

- 1. Metta Technologies, Inc. \$81,260.00
- 2. Coastal Netting Systems \$82,500.00

Metta Technologies, Inc. is the apparent low bidder and meets all specifications.
