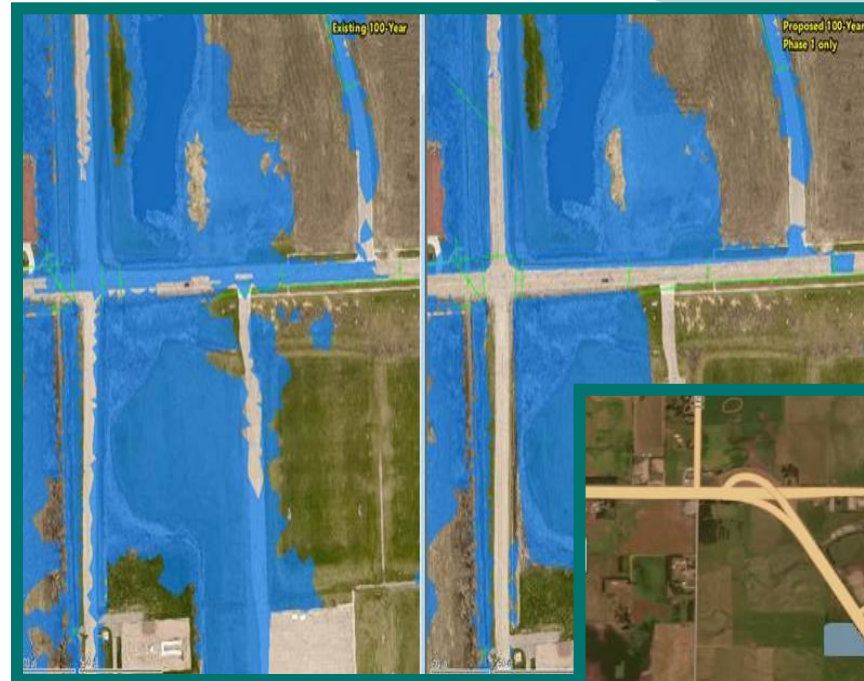

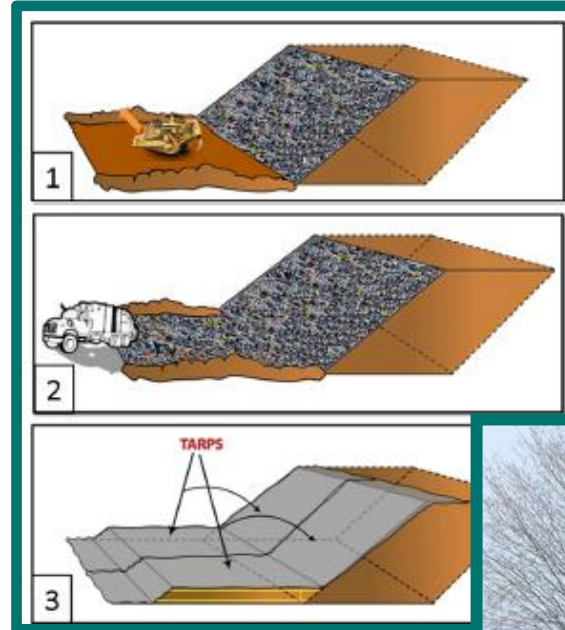

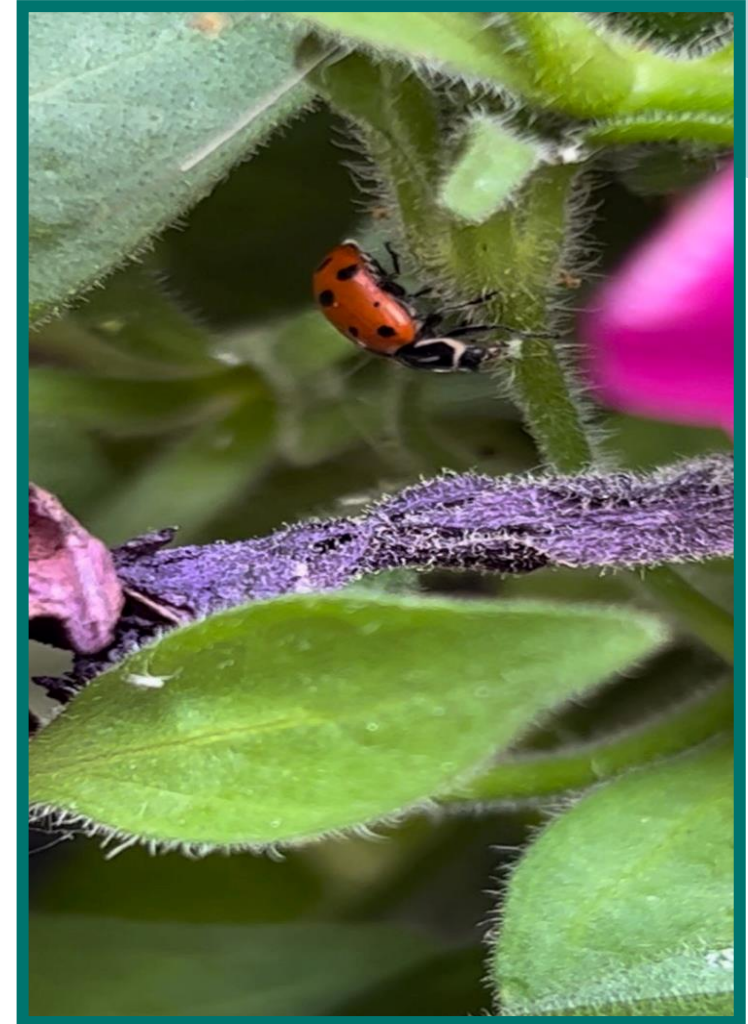
Police

Parks and Recreation

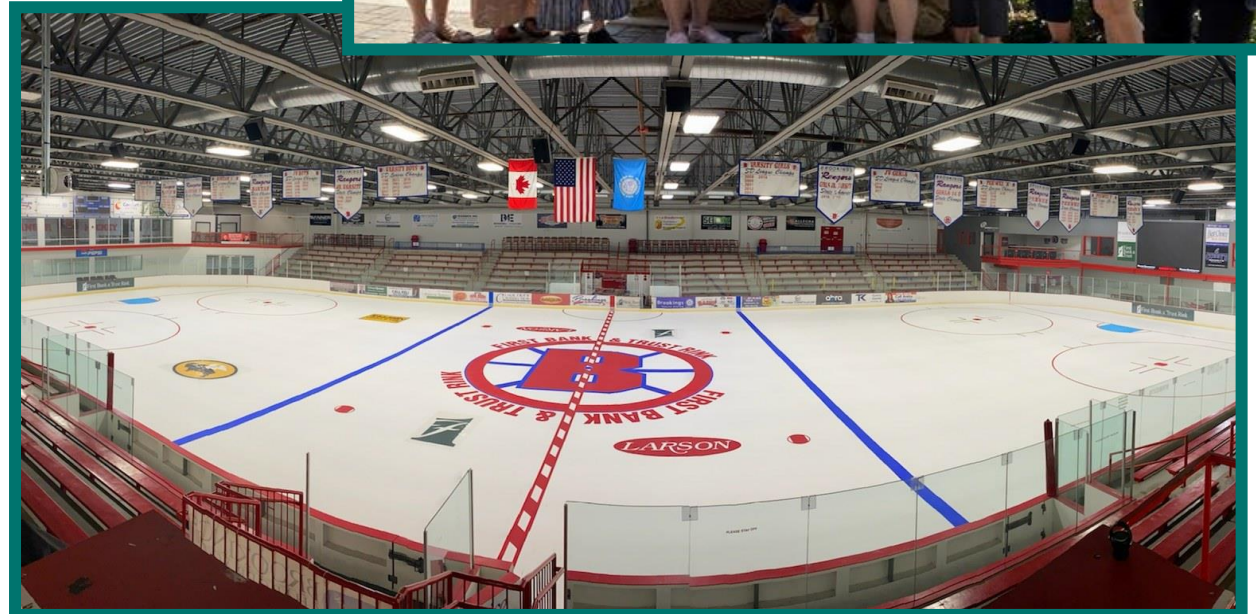
- Pioneer Park
