Summary and Recommended Action:

Legacy Storage Condos, LLC, has submitted a petition to rezone Lot 1 in Clark Addition and Lot 2 in Clark Second Addition from an Agriculture A District to a Business B-3 Heavy District. The Planning Commission voted 9-0 recommending approval. Staff recommends approval.

Item Details:

Lot 1 in Clark Addition is a 1.94-acre parcel of land located at 704 34th Avenue. The parcel is currently zoned Agriculture and located within a General Industrial future land use class which supports the Business B-3 Heavy District request. Adjacent property is zoned Agriculture to the east and west, Industrial I-1 Light District to the north, and Business B-2 District to the south.

Lot 2 in Clark Second Addition is a 1.7-acre lot of land located to the east of Lot 1 in Clark Addition. The parcel is currently zoned Agriculture. The parcel was included in a recent annexation petition and Future Land Use Map amendment. The Future Land Use Map is now Business Park / Light Industrial, which would support the proposed Business B-3 Heavy District request. Adjacent property is zoned Agriculture to the north and east, Industrial I-1 Light District to the west, and Business B-2 District to the south.

No portion of the rezone areas are impacted by the Floodplain Map.
