- Things to consider: What sets this project apart from other Parks & Rec initiatives? How does this fit into public art?
 - Potential approaches: Outdoor maker space. Provide an area for children to install their art in public.
 - Potential approaches: Interactive, visual & colorful components. Equipment that encourages children to engage in the natural world.
 - Potential approaches: Teacher training for utilizing the outdoor space for public art projects with learners. Or opening day art making led by

community orgs such as Brookings Arts Council.

Future needs: To vote on the final budget and products for the outdoor space.
