## BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS

#### **2026 BUDGET**

- 2026 Budget is almost \$650k less than 2025
  - \$1M General Fund increase
  - Balanced budgeting
  - Positive sales tax growth

#### **TAX REVENUE**

- 3% sales tax increase expected over 2025 adopted budget
- 5% property tax growth

#### INITIATIVES

- New city attorney relationship
- Ordinance recodification
- Salary survey in 2026 to be implemented in 2027
- Continued investment in employees
  - Wages
  - Professional development & training
- Addition of 5th Street Gym


