

**RESOLUTION 20-28**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATERTOWN  
DESIGNATING ANZA SOCCER COMPLEX AS A PERMISSIBLE FIREWORKS  
DISCHARGE LOCATION ON JULY 4, 2020**

**WHEREAS** the Watertown Parks, Recreation, and Forestry Board, pursuant to City Ordinance Section 13.0303, prohibited the discharge of fireworks at Stoke-Thomas Lake City Park indefinitely; and

**WHEREAS** the Watertown Parks, Recreation, and Forestry Board recommended to the City Council allowing the discharge of fireworks on July 4, 2020 at Anza Soccer Complex in order to provide a substitute location this year for those who might have otherwise discharged fireworks at Stokes-Thomas Lake City Park;

**WHEREAS** the City Council of City of Watertown has considered the issue as recommended and agrees that making the recommended accommodation is appropriate;

**NOW, THEFEFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that, pursuant to City Ordinance Section 13.0303, Anza Soccer Complex shall be designated as a location at which fireworks may be discharged on July 4, 2020 from 12:00pm until 11:59pm. This resolution does not relieve any person from complying with all other ordinances, regulations, and laws related to the discharge and use of fireworks specifically including, but not limited to, those that require licensing and permitting for the use of certain types of fireworks.
