#### **Summary:**

Jack's Hospitality, dba The Bank Saloon and Vault, is at the 5-year mid-term renewal for the 10-year Operating Agreement for the On-Sale Liquor License, issued in 2019. Staff recommends approval of the renewal.

# **Background:**

The City of Brookings enters into On-Sale Liquor Operating Agreements for a 10-year period, with a mid-term renewal at five years. This Resolution would allow the City Manager to enter into the remaining 5-years of the 10-year agreement. The original 10-year Agreement was entered into May 2019.
