physical, social-emotional, sensory, cognitive, and communicative benefits of play.

#### **DEVELOPMENTAL PRIORITIZATION**

#### Developmental Prioritization of Play Activities

Understanding the developmental features and benefits of play activities helps communities effectively prioritize and provide variety to create truly inclusive experiences. The following examples address the developmental needs of the whole child by intentionally providing opportunities for physical, social-emotional, sensory, cognitive, and communicative development. Some examples may offer a primary benefit, while others have been designed to address several categories of development.


