

Public Progress Hearing

Your local unit of government will need to conduct a public hearing to discuss the progress of the project and to outline any concerns that may exist concerning the project. The public hearing may be held during a regular meeting of the local government and **be conducted before the second draw down** or when concerns arise. Notice of the hearing must be published at least once in the local newspaper of general distribution 15 days prior to the hearing. Citizens must be given a 30-day comment period post hearing.

The following items must be submitted to the CDBG Office:

- A. Copy of the public notice of the hearing and affidavit or full tear sheet;
- B. Minutes of the meeting;
- C. Listing of concerns, if any; and
- D. Methods selected to satisfactorily address the concerns.
