March 2020

STATISTICS

- Print circulation in February was up compared with 2019. 2019 – 14,064; 2020 – 15,712, a 10.5% increase.
- Ebook usage in February was up 17.5% from last year: 2019-3,042; 2020- 3,687.
- E-magazine (Zinio) usage in February is significantly down from last year. 2019- 116— 2020- 19
- Computer lab use in February is up from last year: 2019 – 1,230; 2020 – 1,312. A 6.25% increase.
- Wireless internet connections in February were 1,011. 2019 –1,390; 2020—1,011 a decrease of 37%.
- Registered borrowers now stand at 10,981 as of 03/02/20.
- Walk-in Count: 10,424
