

OFFICIAL MINUTES

OFFICIAL SUMMARY

Item #4a – This is an annexation request of about 12 acres of agricultural land and 1.5 acres of right-of-way, just outside of the city limits. This is consistent with the City's Comprehensive Plan. Rasmussen wondered why Block 23 isn't included in this request. Struck explained that the applicants live near this annexation area and they are going to keep the Block 23 portion with their acreage at this time.
