



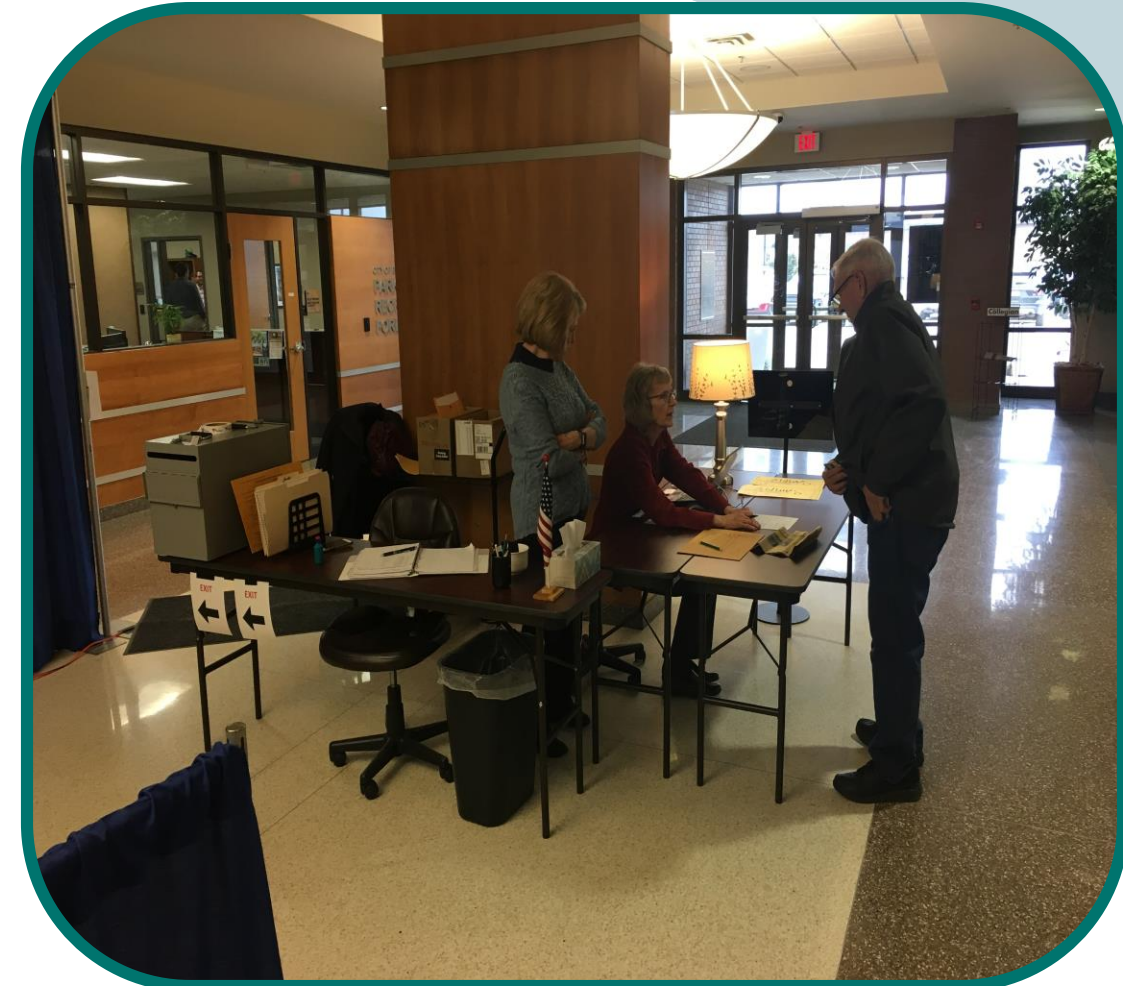

# Library

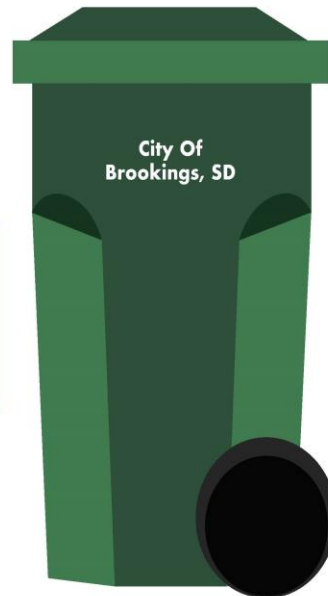
- Friends of the Library's Grab Bag Book Sale began on Tuesday, March 16
