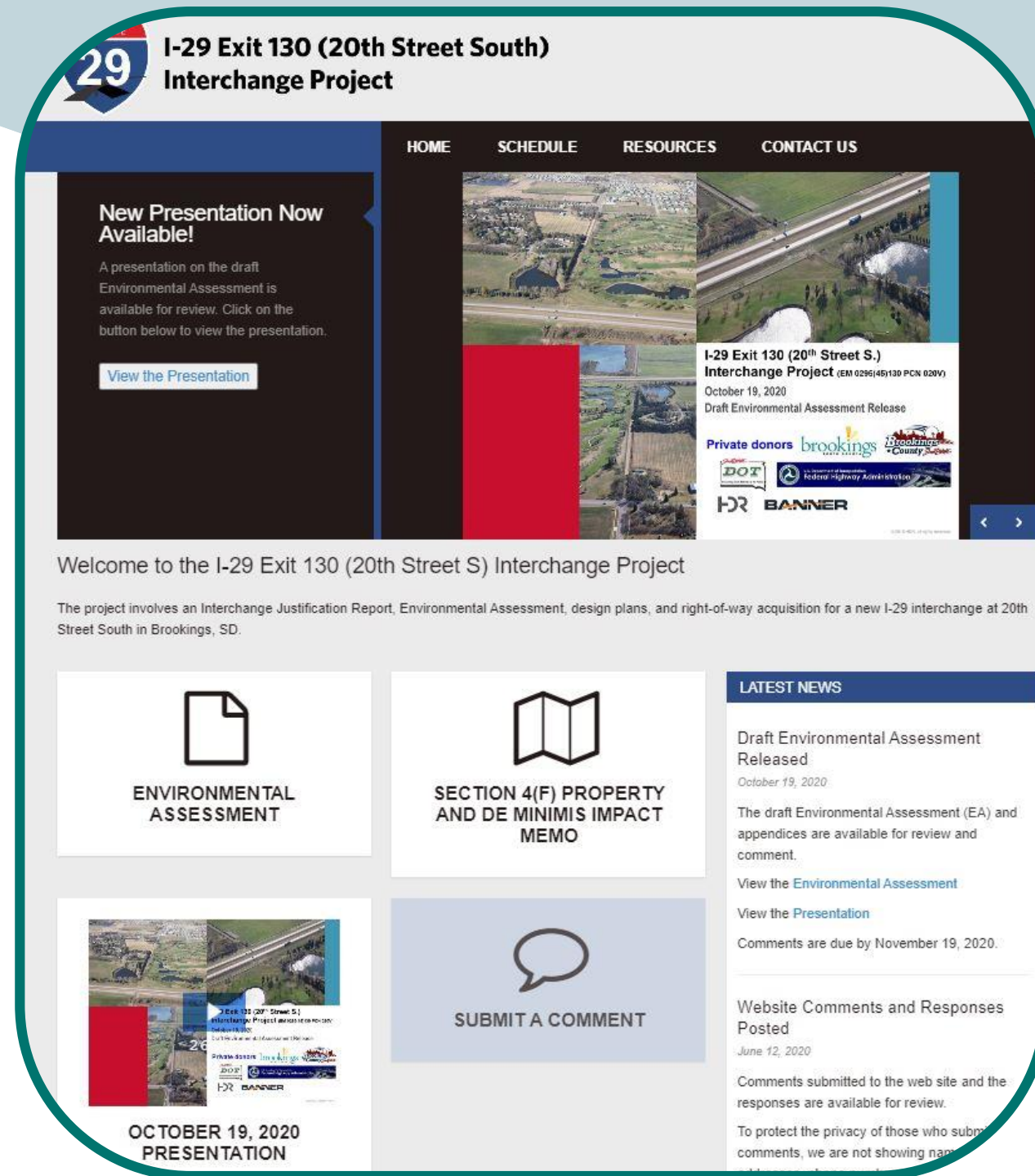
Food Insecurity Facility

Rain Garden

- City/County Government Center
 - *South Parking Lot*
- Promotes stormwater infiltration
- Features
 - *Approximately 500 stormwater friendly plants*
 - *Underdrain system*
 - *Stone wall slows entry to storm sewer system*
 - *Educational Signage*
 - *Volume and Quality Monitoring*
- 2-3 years for full bloom
