Ordinance 20-007 was enacted to reduce the spread of COVID-19 and provides additional requirements to restaurants, bars, grocery, casino, gyms, salons as well as other similar businesses. This ordinance is set to expire July 14th.

June 30th Ordinance 20-010 was read to extend the current regulations with the addition of bars. If approved July 7th the ordinance would be extended for an additional sixty (60) days.

Background:

The current emergency COVID-19 regulation through Ordinance 20-007 has the following implications:

Restaurants/Bars

- Maximum of ten customers or 50% occupancy, whichever is greater
 - Occupancy capacity posted at front entry
- Groups of ten (10) or less and six (6) feet apart
- Cleaning of high touch areas/materials between users
- Screening employees recommended
- Employees required to wear masks
- Cleaning of used spaces before and after each customer

- No self-serve buffets or salad bars
- No sharing of condiments unless wiped between use
- Grocery, Casino, Gyms, and Recreational Facilities
 - Cleaning of equipment after use by customer and/or employee
 - Maximum of ten customers or 50% occupancy
 - Occupancy capacity posted at front entry
 - Employees of Grocery stores will wear masks
 - Protective measures/operations will be provided
- Salons/Barber Shops
 - Customers six (6) feet spacing & recommend service by appointment-only
 - Employees will wear masks
 - Clean equipment before and after each customer
 - Adequate social distancing for waiting customers
- Administrative exemptions allow for requested flexibility.

At the June 30th City Council meeting, City Council voted to amend the ordinance to continue current regulations with the addition of bars.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends City Council to provide direction on Ordinance.
