Residency Requirement: Required

Purpose: The City Planning Commission is responsible for the city comprehensive plan for the physical development of the city, including areas outside the boundaries of the city and within the planning jurisdiction. The Board of Adjustment has the authority to act on variances or special exceptions to the zoning ordinance.

With the passage of Ordinance 22-006, the Board of Adjustment members will be the appointed current Planning Commission members. The Board of Adjustment terms will be consistent with the Planning Commission member terms.
